Homemade Baby Wipes

- 1 Rubbermaid container (6 cup)
- Bounty paper towels, cut in half width wise
- 1-1/2 cups water
- 2 Tbs. Baby shampoo or baby wash
- 2 Tbs. Baby oil
- 2 Tbs. Witch hazel (optional)

Put paper towels in the container. Mix water and other ingredients in a large glass. Pour over paper towels. Cover with lid and wait 15 minutes. Pull wipes out from center and use as needed.
