As the year progresses and many more students join our program, our classes will become increasingly noisier and full of activity. Therefore, when siblings join our groups it adds to the activity and noise level. Please be aware of the children in the session who are in need of special education services. Sometimes, a lot of extra noise makes it difficult for the children to concentrate and learn. If it is possible, leave the siblings at home with a sitter, or a helpful grandparent.

Sneezes and Sniffles

As an additional reminder: We need to be extra cautious that we don't carry any germs to school. Please be careful not to bring a "fever, runny nose, sneeze, or cough" to school. Please, do not bring your child to therapy when he/she is sick, for everyone's protection. In addition, children are unable to fully participate when they are not feeling well. If a sibling is too sick to go to school, they are too sick to come to MIPP.
