

Converting Old Local ROSES 'Data' Databases

Sometimes, the ROSES application installation instructions tell you to convert the 'Data' Databases with a conversion program. Unfortunately, technical support persons sometimes forget to convert **all** of the **primary** (PR####.MDB) and **frozen** (FR#####.MDB) 'Data' databases.

If a ROSES operator tries to open an unconverted 'Data' Database with the ROSES application, the operator gets a message such as:

The 'Data' Database Version is: ###
ROSES Software Version ### requires ROSES 'Data' Database Version ### or above.

Then, the technical support person must run the appropriate conversion program(s) to bring the 'Data' database to the version required by the ROSES application software.

The following table shows which conversion program brings a 'data' database to which version. (The conversion programs are stored in the **ROSES Application Folder**.)

After the table, you will find some examples of how to use the table.

Example #1: Suppose that when you try to open a 'Data' database, you get the following message:

The 'Data' Database Version is: 5.06

ROSES Software Version 5.30 requires ROSES 'Data' Database Version 5.30 or above.

Here is how to convert the database:

1. Backup the database. (Copy the database to a special folder on the network.)
2. Since the **Cv021Jun.Exe** program converted the 'Data' database to version **5.06**, you must run the following conversion programs to bring the 'Data' database to version **5.30**: **Cv022Sep.Exe**, **Cv023Nov.Exe**, **Cv024Jan.Exe**, **Cv025Sep.Exe** and **CV026Mar.Exe**.

Example #2: Suppose that when you run a conversion program, you get the following message:

Your database version is: 5.06

Your database version must be at least 5.30 before you can run this conversion program.

Here is how to convert the database:

1. Backup the database. (Copy the database to a special folder on the network.)
2. Since the **Cv021Jun.Exe** program converted the 'Data' database to version **5.06**, you must run the following conversion programs to bring the 'Data' database to version **5.30**: **Cv022Sep.Exe**, **Cv023Nov.Exe**, **Cv024Jan.Exe**, **Cv025Sep.Exe** and **CV026Mar.Exe**.
