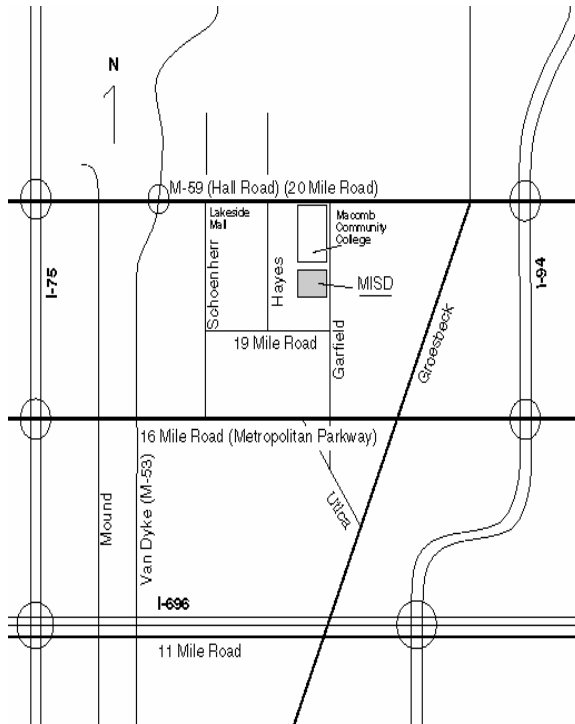


Information worth knowing.....
