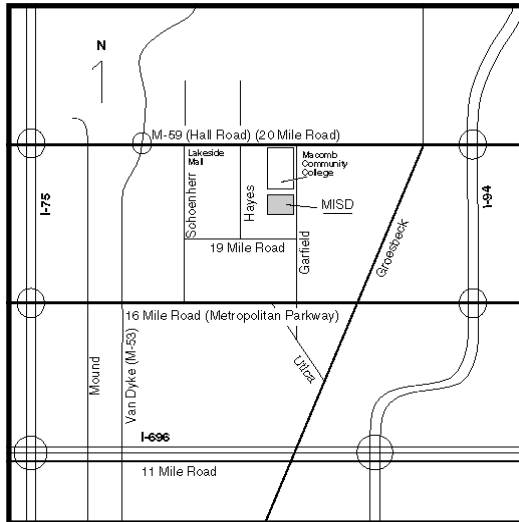




### How to Register

Bullying behavior affects all students' ability to learn by undermining emotional and physical safety in school that is so essential for learning.

Participants will learn a research-based process that will substantially change bullying behavior in their school.

Strategies discussed will fold readily into existing behavior-based initiatives, such as Positive Behavior Supports and Character Education.

- Establish consistency of response with a behavior rubric
