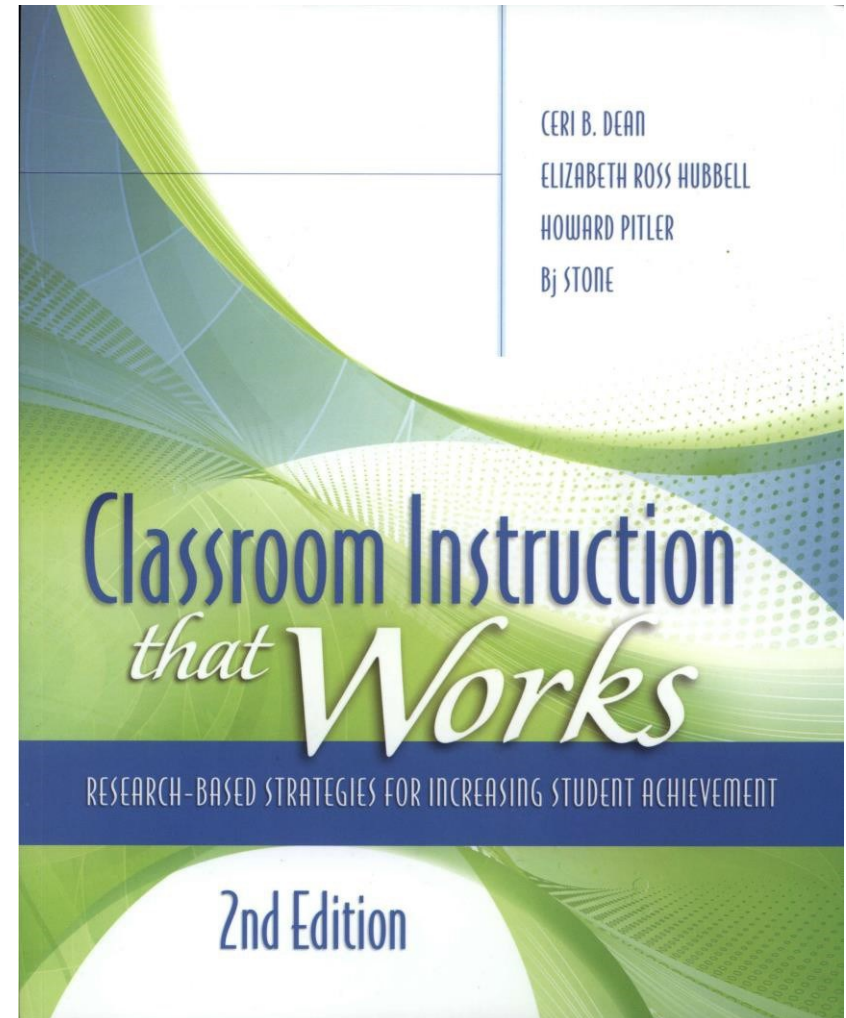

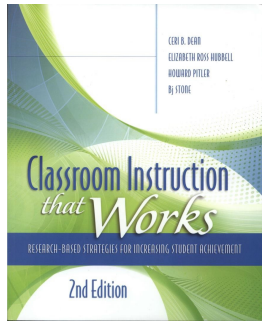

Classroom Instruction That Works

This workshop presents an overview of the best instructional practices as found in the research literature and then shows how these practices can be implemented in the classroom. Specific types of knowledge such as vocabulary, terms and phrases, details, generalizations, and principles are applied to instructional practices, and a model for sequencing instructional techniques is also examined.

Available from the Association for Supervision and Curriculum Development (ASCD), this manual distills decades of research on effective instructional strategies that maximize student learning.
