MISD MATH MINDSET SUMMER CAMP 2019



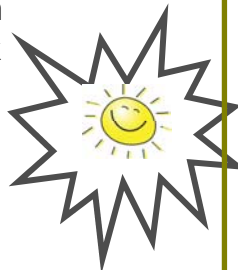
The Macomb Intermediate School District is offering a summer math camp for students entering 7th or 8th grade who believe mathematics is not their strength. Our goal is to communicate the brain research to math students and teach them through an approach that is open, creative and visual. The term “growth mindset” comes from the work of Carol Dweck. Her studies show that everyone holds ideas about their own potential. Students with a fixed mindset are those who are more likely to give up easily, whereas students with a growth mindset are those who keep on going even when work is hard, and who are persistent. The curriculum is based on a model used at Stanford University with 81 students with a wide range of achievement levels. Students in the study demonstrated 1.6 years of growth after 18 days of instruction. (Jo Boaler, Mathematics Education Professor, Stanford University) www.youcubed.org

Macomb Intermediate School District Responsibilities

- The MISD will provide 2 days of professional development for all teachers teaching the summer camp program.

June 18-19, 2019 - 8:30 a.m.- 3:00 p.m.

- The MISD will provide two-days of professional development
- The MISD will provide teacher salaries for each district
- The MISD will provide journals for students
- The MISD will provide a 20 day course curriculum
- The MISD will provide funding for a healthy snack for each participant
- The MISD will provide support for teachers during program



Local School District Responsibilities

- Each district should invite any “**dynamic growth-minded**” facilitators/teachers, who are willing to be trained in June, to fill out the [Teacher Interest Form](#) by **May 31, 2019**
- Each district must register their accepted teachers for professional development at the Macomb ISD by **May 31, 2019**
- Each district must provide counselors and/or teachers to **recruit** students
- Each district must provide a student class list no later than **June 7, 2019**
- Each district must provide a site and identify an administrator available during summer hours
- Each district site should have computers and technical support available during summer hours, **July 8 - Aug. 8**
- \$200 (\$100/day) stipend for Macomb County Teachers to attend training
