

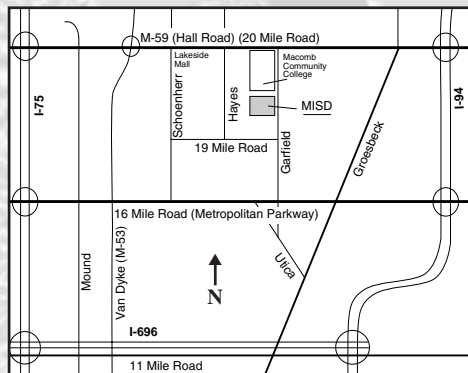


Myth

What
