

SAT Khan Academy Schoology Course With Peer-to-Peer Tutoring

This **asynchronous** course will provide incoming juniors an opportunity to explore the tools available on the College Board Student Portal and the free SAT prep that is available through Khan Academy. The course will help each student link their accounts, so that Khan Academy will use their College Board test scores to develop a personalized plan. This plan will identify specific content each student should practice to be more successful on the SAT. Students will be able to work through the course at their own pace and schedule.

Student will want to complete the Schoology Coursework as soon as possible so they can spend more time practicing as many items as they can from their personalized plan in Khan Academy. **This will also allow students to take full advantage of virtual peer-to-peer tutoring**. The tutoring component is something NEW this summer and will provide students support as they work through their personalized plan in Khan Academy. Students will be able to attend scheduled tutoring sessions to receive support from peers who have already taken the SAT and are part of the Macomb Early College Program.

Students will gain insight on how to navigate SAT Khan Academy and College Board Student Portal so that they can continue using these tools, especially the free SAT prep, well after this course ends. The top three students from each session who completes the course and answers the most correct SAT practice items in Khan Academy will earn a \$10 gift card. The winners will be contacted by email a few days after each session closes.

Who: 2022-23 Junior Students

When: Choose <u>one</u> session from the options below. Students are expected to "join the course" in Schoology prior to the start of each session. There will an <u>optional</u> meeting for those who need assistance troubleshooting and/or for those who can't "join" the course. More information and directions on how to join a course in Schoology will be emailed to the address <u>given at registration</u> **two business days prior** to the start of class.

This course is asynchronous, which means the students can complete the coursework at their own pace. Students will want to complete the Schoology Coursework as soon as possible, which will allow them to take full advantage of virtual peer-to-peer tutoring.

Where: Coursework is completed online through Schoology. Students will also access Khan Academy and College Board Student Portal. Students will need logins for both systems if they already have accounts. The peer-to-peer tutoring will be conducted through Zoom. Links will be available through the Schoology course.

Materials Needed: A Chromebook, laptop, or tablet with the latest version of Google Chrome, Firefox, Safari 9+, or Microsoft Edge is required. Mobile apps or when using a mobile browser on a smaller device like a <u>phone will not work</u>.

Course Details:

This course will...

- Provide directions on how to link accounts between College Board Student Portal and Khan Academy, so that a personalized plan will be created for the student.
- Provide explicit directions to utilize College Board Student Portal for the following:
 - o Identify weaker sub-score areas and questions the student answered incorrectly
 - Use Skills Insight, which is provided by College Board to identify suggested skills to enhance student performance
 - College search and scholarship opportunities

Please note for student to be able to complete the items above they must have previously taken a College Board test.

- Provide explicit directions to utilize Khan Academy Free SAT Prep Course for the following:
 - Create a practice schedule, view previous College Board test results, current skill levels, and share practice activities with a coach.
 - Use the recommended skills practice to increase student performance
 - Learn the differences between the skills library and recommended practice
 - Use tips, strategies and the 8 full practice tests to prepare for the test

The instruction and test strategies will be provided by Khan Academy. The course instructors will assist with technical troubleshooting like linking accounts or navigating through the Schoology course, as well as monitoring student progress through the recommended practice. The course instructors will also monitor tutoring sessions through Zoom. The top three students who complete the course and answer the most correct SAT practice items in Khan Academy will earn a \$10 gift card.
