<b>GSRP/PreK for All Prioritization Process</b>

## 2025-2026

January 1- April 30	<ul> <li>Age-eligible children (4 yrs of age by September 1st).</li> <li>Families with income up to 400% FPL.</li> <li>Families under 100% FPL must be referred to Head Start.</li> <li>Families indicating homelessness, foster care, or IEPs must be prioritized.</li> <li>*Saving 10% (reserved percentage) of total site allocation for late enrollment.</li> </ul>
May 1	<ul> <li>Age-eligible (4yrs of age by September 1st), families exceeding 400% FPL. Prioritize by eligibility factors.</li> <li>*Saving 10% (reserved percentage) of total site allocation for late enrollment.</li> </ul>
July 1	<ul> <li>Early-entry children, those who turn 4 yrs of age between September 2 and December 1st, if all age-eligible (4 yrs of age by September 1st) children have been placed.</li> <li>*Saving 10% (reserved percentage) of total site allocation for late enrollment.</li> </ul>
August 1	Fill the remaining 10% (reserved percentage) of allocated seats, prioritizing lowest income/highest needs families first.
August 15	If openings remain from the reserved percentage, enroll any remaining families including those with income exceeding 400% FPL up and those that have completed a <b>Self-Reported Income Documentation</b> form, to the full allocation.
