January 1- February 1	Begin collecting applications for age eligible children
Begin Formal Enrollment	
February 1- April 30	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Age-eligible children (4 yrs of age by September 1, 2026). ● Families with income up to 400% FPL. ● Families under 100% FPL must be referred to Head Start. ● Families indicating the following prioritization factors: <u>homelessness, foster care, or IEP</u> (General Education Setting) must be prioritized. <p>*Saving 10% (reserved percentage) of total site allocation for late enrollment.</p>
May 1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Age-eligible (4 yrs of age by September 1, 2026), families exceeding 400% FPL. ● Families indicating the following prioritization factors: <u>homelessness, foster care, or IEP</u> (General Education Setting) must be prioritized. <p>*Saving 10% (reserved percentage) of total site allocation for late enrollment.</p>
August 1	<p>Fill the remaining 10% (reserved percentage) of allocated seats, prioritizing lowest income/highest needs families first as well as any family that refuses to self-report their household income.</p> <p>*Exhaust all age-eligible children prior to early entry children.</p>
August 10	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Early-entry children, those who turn 4 years of age between September 2 and December 1st, if all age-eligible (4 yrs of age by September 1, 2026) children have been placed.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ★ Any family that refuses to self-report their household income will be documented in the highest income bracket FPL 500%+. ★ As a reminder programs need to continue filling open GSRP seats. This should be going on all year to ensure we serve as many children as we can. Open seats may result in a reduction of GSRP funding.
