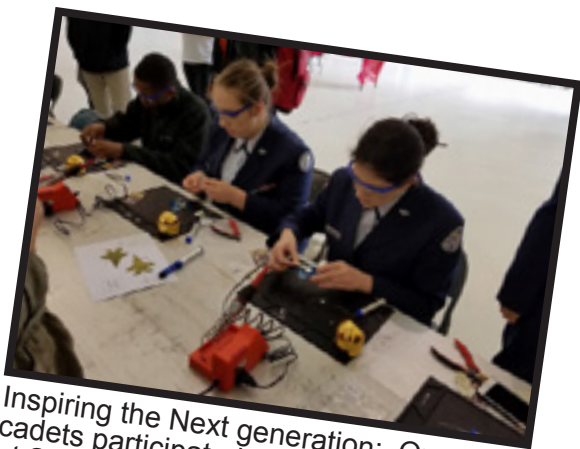

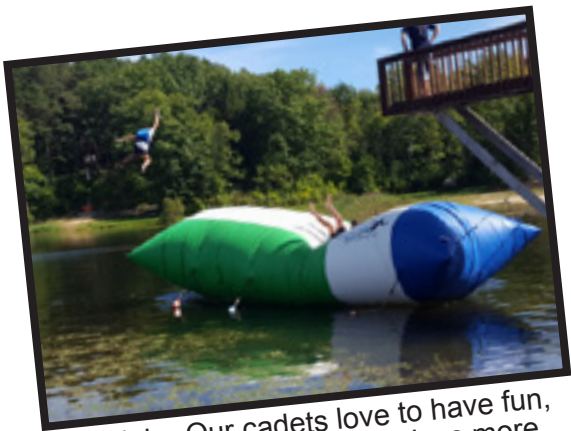
COLTS team Building: We make team-building and leadership training fun!

This one-hour class is held at the high school, and is open to all students in grades 9 through 12. For over 25 years, we have been providing our students leadership and growth opportunities. They challenge themselves, they practice communication and leadership skills, they build teams, and they set themselves up for success both inside and outside of high school.

With our AFJROTC there is no military commitment, and our teachers are not military recruiters. They are retired career military professionals, with a lifetime of leadership experience in a variety of career fields. Our teachers are dedicated to helping our students reach their full potential. They will help your student best prepare for college; vocational school; a job; or, entering the military. No one does it better.

Last school year, our classes provided over \$3,000 in college scholarships through the efforts of our Booster Club. Our students earned two West Point Military Academy nominations and two full-ride college ROTC scholarships. Many of our students go on to attend major colleges. Thirty-four of our students received high school academic awards—three seniors graduated with honors! Why not join our program and gain these benefits, too?

Our classes are open to everyone, and students may earn physical education, applied arts/foreign language, and even general elective credit just for taking one of our classes. Uniforms are worn just one day a week, and are provided free of charge. There are scholarship opportunities for all of our events and activities based on financial need. Anchor Bay High School is a school of choice, so parents/guardians may elect to have their students attend our high school. All students are welcome.

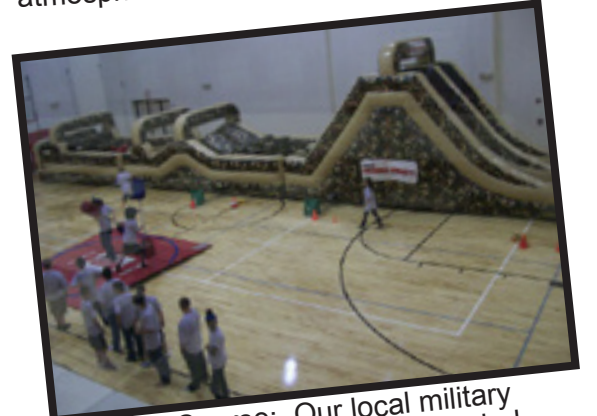
