PreK-12 Literacy Framework

This framework focuses on Tier I and was created as a guide districts and schools to development and implement the PreK- 12 literacy plan. It does not include everything, however, everything in the document should be evident for every student, in every classroom, every day. They finished the presentation with their professional learning opportunities. The ELA stated that they want to help districts tailor a plan to each district.
