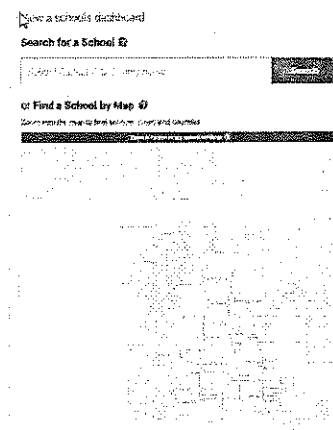
Launches Today!

- Began with conversations related to the Every Student Succeeds Act (2015)
- Requested by parents and other education stakeholders
- Initiated by State Board of Education policy (2017)
- Has been architected, designed, tested, and is now implemented



An Easy-to-Use Parent Dashboard

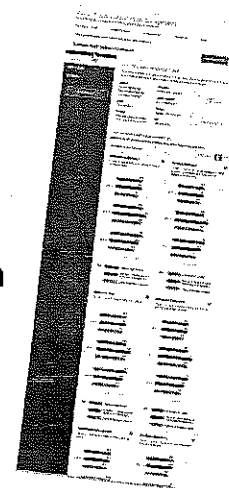
- Provides one easy location where parents and caregivers can view **building-level** data they say are important to them
- Offers a more balanced picture of school quality, since it contains information about more than just test scores
- Shows the performance of every public school in Michigan, including public school academies



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Dashboard Features

- Quickly find a school, learn about it, view its performance, and drill in for more detail
- Compare a school's performance over 3 years to peer schools and the State of Michigan
- Find answers to common questions within each page, or through Help or Contact pages
- Easily share and print information from any page
- Learn more about overall State of Michigan performance on similar indicators

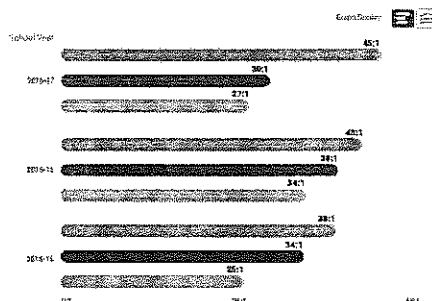

This graph shows the ratio of students to instructional staff at the school, similar schools, and state for each of the most recent three years. The ratio is expressed in terms of Full-Time Equivalency, where "1" represents a full-time staff member.



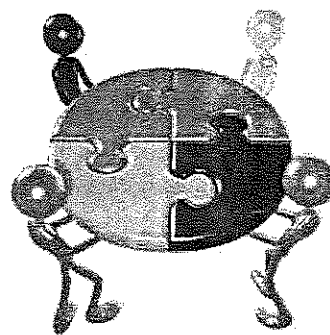
The graph shows from your chosen school up to and other related sources of school data.

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What does it take to build a data dashboard?

- 33 staff collaborating from four different State agencies
- Numerous contracted application developers
- More than 3,000 person hours (plus more developing the application!)
- Integration of data-sets from 10 databases
- Data from over 3,400 public school buildings (includes traditional districts and public school academies)
- Data covering over 1.9 million Michigan students

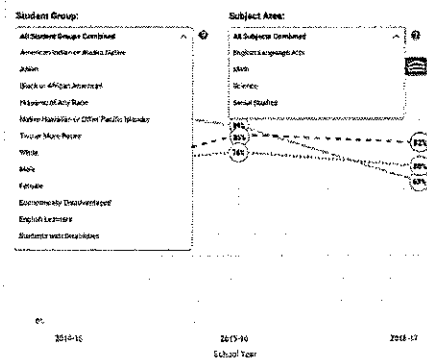

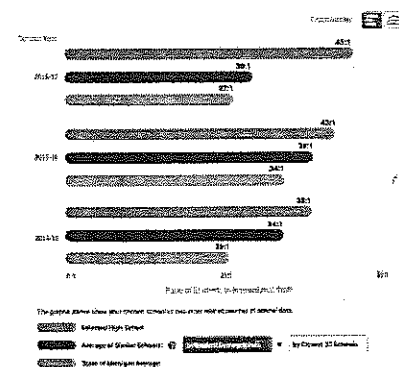

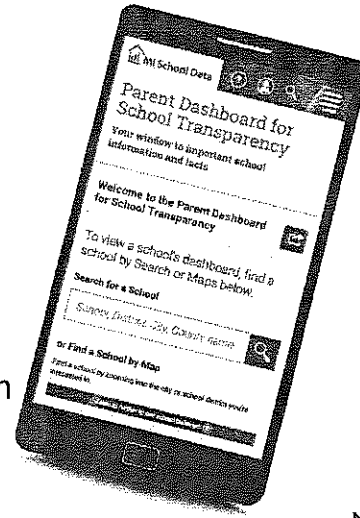
Ratio of Students to Instructional Staff

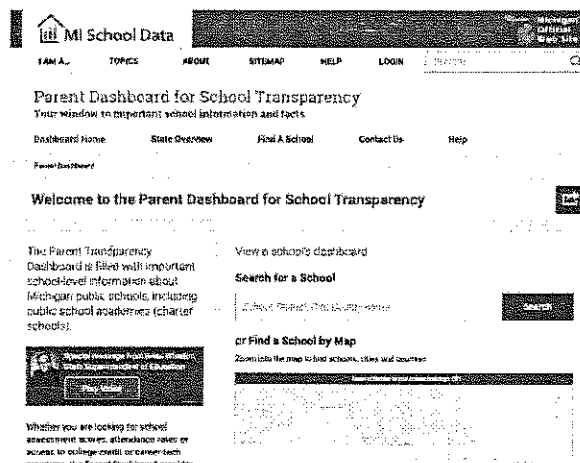
Highlights

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Planned Future Enhancements

- Points of Pride
 - Before- and after-school programming
 - Early Learning access (public system)
 - Wraparound services
 - Extracurricular opportunities
 - Presence of recess
- More customized comparisons
- New data (as available)
 - Access to fine arts, music, physical education and library media specialists
 - Financial reporting (some)
 - Access to technology
 - Services for students with disabilities
 - Services for English Learners
 - Additional financial reporting
 - Climate/Culture surveys
 - Educator engagement
