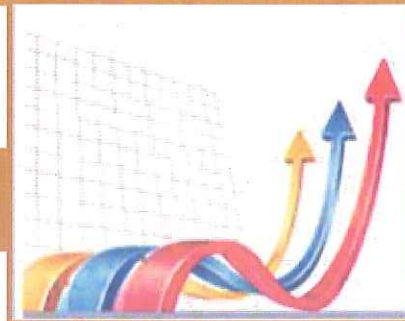

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Beginning in 2018-19,

- Student growth and assessment data must account for 40% of the annual year-end teacher evaluation.
- Half of the student growth portion (20%) of the evaluation must be measured by the state assessments for those teachers in grades 4 - 8 teaching ELA and/or math.

The state will provide Student Growth Percentiles for all applicable students within a district, however the district will be responsible for tracking which student SGP should be linked to individual teachers and aggregating those SGPs.

The day will include an overview of the requirements, the implications in the overall effectiveness rating when student growth includes SGPs, and the possible inequities which could emerge across a district. The SGP Educator Evaluation Calculator tool developed by MDE will be highlighted and reviewed.



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
