Meals are available to all students 18 years and younger and/or 26 years and younger for adult/children with special needs. Our goal is to provide all students with the opportunity to pick up meals in a safe and comfortable environment so that they are ready to succeed in any type of learning environment. ARTS ACADEMY IN THE WOODS	Arts Academy is providing 2 meals per day for 7 days each week for pick up on Thursdays.

ARMADA	<p>Armada Schools 20-21 Lunch/Breakfast</p> <p><u>Krause Elementary</u> Breakfast Grab and Go, eat in the classroom, 2 carts, in 2 locations Lunch Daily orders received Via Teachers, with milk choice, 1 option for lunch, we pack per child, per classroom, and they eat in the classroom.</p> <p><u>Armada Middle School</u> Breakfast Grab and go, cart located in the hall, Students eat in the classroom Lunch Meal orders via teachers, we pack per student/per order, 1 lunch option currently, some hot, some cold, students pick up meals in cafeteria, and select milk, and take back to their classroom to eat.</p> <p><u>Armada High School</u> Breakfast grab and go, students come to the serving line, pick up, take to classroom to eat. Lunch, offering 2 options per day, students come to the serving area, select meal and milk, and then take to the classroom to eat.</p> <p><u>Virtual (approx 400)</u> 1 day per week distribution 5, Breakfast & Lunch per package, per child, Parents sign up via a google form, and we pack accordingly. Wednesday's Distribution currently. 1-3:30 At Armada High School. (we are struggling with enough cooler/freezer space, so this is a huge challenge)</p>
CENTER LINE	<p>Center Line schools are doing curbside pickup on Monday (3 breakfasts/3 lunches) & Thursday (4 breakfasts & 4 lunches) from 11:00-12:30 at the following 5 locations Center Line High School Wolfe Middle School Crothers Elementary Peck Elementary & Roose Elementary We are also doing evening pickups (by request) at the high school on distribution days.</p>
CHIPPEWA VALLEY	<p>Chippewa Valley is fully virtual and providing meals daily M-F from 9am -11am at the following buildings: Cheyenne Elementary Clinton Valley Elementary Huron Elementary Iroquois Middle School</p>

EASTPOINTE	<p>We are Serving breakfast in the classrooms at K-7 Schools. Breakfast in the cafeteria 8-12. Virtual students and community children can pick up Breakfast and Lunch meals on Tuesday (3 days) and Thursday (4 days) from 1-3 pm HS only 1pm -6 pm Face to Face students can pick up 3 lunch meals on Tuesday and 2 breakfast and 4 lunch meals on Thursday from 1-3 pm HS only 1pm -6 pm A very small number of families have reached out to the food service department and we deliver to their homes on Tuesday (3 meals) and Thursday (4 Meals)</p>

FITZGERALD	<p>Fitzgerald's food service model is as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Friday distribution at Schofield Elementary School & Fitzgerald High School from 11:00 AM- 1:00 PM. We are giving out 7 days worth of breakfasts and 7 days of lunches. - After hours distribution at Mound Park Elementary School from 4:30 PM- 6:00 PM every Friday. Families must pre-order for after hours meals but we always have some extras just in case of walk ups. - We have staff childcare at each school building as well as SACC everyday and are providing breakfast and lunch to those students. We also have ECSE in school on Monday & Wednesday and are providing breakfast and lunch to those students as well.
FRASER	<p>Fraser Public Schools is all virtual for the time being. We are providing meals at our High School from 7am - 11am daily Monday thru Friday, distributing breakfast & lunch together. In addition, we have SACC childcare at each elementary school that we are delivering meals to, but we do not have these locations open for pick-up.</p>
LAKE SHORE	<p>We are feeding face to face kids everyday breakfast and take home lunch, all buildings.</p> <p>We distribute on Mondays and Thursday's from 11:15-1 and 4-6 for the community and our virtual kiddos.</p>

L'ANSE CREUSE	<p>We are providing breakfast and lunch for in-person learning at all grade levels and buildings. We are also providing meal kits for our virtual students.</p> <p><u>Elementary Schools</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ All elementary buildings are breakfast in the classroom. ➤ Lunch is congregate feeding in the cafes. <p><u>Middle & High Schools</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Breakfast and lunch is congregate feeding in the cafes. <p><u>Virtual Students</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ We are open restricted for our meal kits. ➤ Weekly meal kits are distributed once a week on Wednesday mornings from 8:30am-9:30am at both high schools. ➤ Parents pre-order meal kits.
MISD	<p>In Person Learning Food Model – began Wednesday 9/16. Lutz is currently not receiving meals at school</p> <p>100% Virtual Learners Food Model – Food will be produced at Sterling Heights HS for a one week distribution on Wednesdays. 8 buses will go down to Sterling on Wednesdays arriving at approximately 10:30. They'll pick up their bulk meal kits in thermal coolers and deliver to our 8 buildings. They are Bozymowski, Flynn, Maple Lane, Rockwell, Neil Reid, Bovenschen, Glen Peters, and Lutz. After in school lunch service has ended, the food staff will add milks to these meals, and there will be a bulk distribution at each building in the early afternoon. We are working with Transportation to determine the times buses arrive at the building, to determine the distribution times. We are trying to have the pick up time between the end of lunch service and bus pickup.</p> <p>A/B Cohort Schedule – Is taking place at Glen Peters, Bovenschen, and Lutz. 3 buses will go down to Sterling Heights HS on Monday and Tuesday of each week at approximately 10:30 am. They'll pick up two days' worth of meals for one cohort on Monday, and those meals will be distributed on the bus routes for the in person learners to take home with them. The same will happen on Tuesday for the other cohort of in person learners. For both the virtual learners and cohorts, if there are any hardship cases, we discussed having buses deliver those meals directly to the student's home.</p> <p>The intended startup date for the Cohorts Food Model is Monday, October 19th, and the 100% Virtual Learners is Wednesday October 21st.</p>
MOUNT CLEMENS	<p>Mt. Clemens is currently doing meal pick up at Mount Clemens High School and Seminole Elementary on Mondays and Thursdays from 10:00 a.m - 1:00 p.m.</p> <p>We are also utilizing buses for our home deliveries on Mondays and Thursdays between the hours of 9:00 a.m and 1:00 p.m.</p> <p>Three meals are sent on Mondays and four meals are sent on Thursdays</p>

 - Dr. Shepard has offered an order box at the front of the school for pre-ordering of virtual meals.

*Breakfasts will be a variety of the student's favorites like assorted cereals, breakfast bars, muffins, bagels, pop tarts and string cheese. Breakfasts will be served with a fruit or juice and milk.

**I do want to note that as of Monday August 31st, 2020 we will be on the NSLP so we will only be able to provide meals for students for scheduled days of learning.
