TITLE II OF THE AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT (ADA)

SECTION 504 OF THE REHABILITATION ACT OF 1973

Nondiscrimination on Basis of Disability in State and Local Government

No qualified individual with a disability shall, by reason of such disability, be excluded from participation in or be denied the benefits of the services, programs, or activities of the Macomb Intermediate School District (“District”) or be subject to discrimination by the District.

A “qualified individual with a disability” is an individual with a disability who, with or without reasonable modification to rules, policies, or practices, the removal of architectural, communication, or transportation barriers or the provision of auxiliary aids and services, meet the essential eligibility requirements for the receipt of services or the participation in programs or activities provided by the District.

Harassment on the basis of disability and retaliation are also forms of discrimination prohibited by the District and federal civil rights laws.
