7. A solid understanding of web application development processes, from the layout/user interface to relational database structures.

4. Assure quality web solutions by developing and completing test plans and maintaining project and technical documentation.
5. Develop web solutions by specifications/requirements gathering, formulating objectives; planning project life-cycle deliverables and resource availability and application; preparing installation and modification specifications, and leading the exploration, evaluation and design of technical solutions.
6. Provide assistance to the web content provider team, including training, support and documentation.
7. Set up permissions/roles for the web team and answer/direct webmaster email.
8. Perform key work research in coordination with objectives to optimize existing content and uncover new opportunities.
9. Provide SEO analysis and recommendations in coordination with elements and structure of websites and web pages.
10. Perform emergency updates to site as needed.
11. Coordinate with other web systems connected with our site, such as the job application system and the online course registration system—act as contact person for any issues and research alternative systems as needed.
