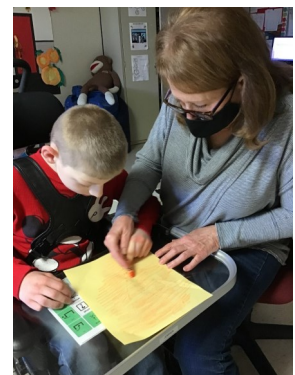
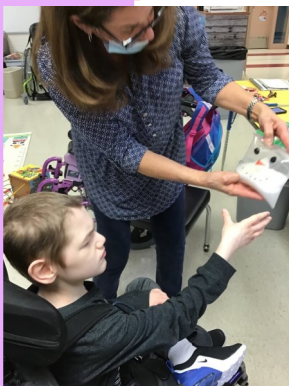
their IEP goals and objectives and enjoy working with Ms. Kristine/PT, Ms. Traci/OT and Ms. Sam/SLP each week.

Spotlight on Room #113

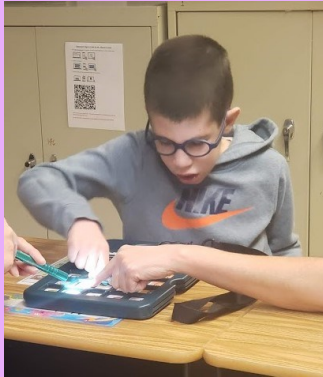
Hello students and families!
