

Specialized Shared Educational Entities (S2E2)

S2E2 are used when the services provided by a cooperative agreement are delivered at multiple sites, sometimes even across districts. For example, a consortium of districts that form an agreement for serving special needs students having one district provide the hearing impaired program, another district houses the autistic classroom and the ISD does the speech services and has classrooms set up in 4 different schools. A single S2E2 code is issued for the "Special Education Consortium" (or whatever the districts want it to be called). This entity is a "child" of one of the districts or the ISD, (just like a regular SEE school), that any of the member districts can use. S2E2s are non-instructional ancillary facilities in EEM, so the students are reported with the School Facility code of the entity in which the services are provided, along with the S2E2 code that identifies the student as being educated under a cooperative agreement. This allows the reporting district to use the building code for a school belonging to any of the member districts as the School Facility code. It also tells MDE that the accountability for this student should not be assigned to the building but should be "sent back" to the resident district.

Example:

Fruit Valley ISD (entity code 01000) is the parent district for the Special Education Services Consortium S2E2 (entity code 00123) with Apple Tree (entity code 01010), Orange Grove (entity code 01020) and Strawberry Fields (entity code 01030) as the other member districts.

Any student reported by any of these districts can be reported with the S2E2 code in the S2E2 characteristic. When the student is reported with the S2E2 code, they may also be reported with any building code from any of the member districts as the School Facility Number. So Apple Tree can report its students that attend the HI class that is housed the Garden Elementary School (entity code 00987) that is a child of Strawberry Fields.

Another situation where this may occur... in the example above, each district would report their own kids but their agreement could be that the ISD reports all the kids. So if the same consortium agreed that the ISD would act as the operating district for all students, the records might look like:

The accountability for these students would be assigned back to their resident district by MDE.
