EARLY CHILDHOOD SPECIAL EDUCATION PERMIT

POLICY & CRITERIA:

NOTE: The Michigan Department of Education, Office of Special Education (MDE, OSE) may issue an Early Childhood Special Education Permit to a candidate when a properly certificated teacher is unavailable for a teaching assignment for children with disabilities or developmental delays, per R. 340.1795.

- 1. The candidate must possess a bachelor's degree or higher, including completion of 15 semester or equivalent hours of appropriate professional education credit.
- 2. The Early Childhood Special Education Permit is effective through June 30 of the school year for which it is issued and may not be transferred.
- 3. The permit may not be renewed for the same individual.
