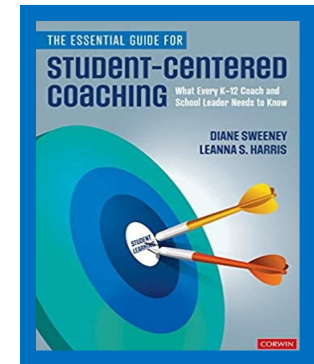
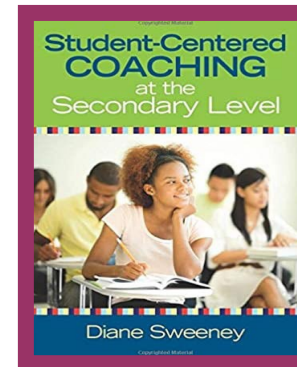
# COACHING MODEL

## In collaboration Macomb County Coaches will:

1. Engage in professional learning sessions surrounding a variety of topics related to day-to-day coaching.

### Topics include;

- a. **Essential Coaching Foundations:** Modeling, co-planning, co-teaching, observing/providing feedback, and facilitating teacher teams to enhance teacher practice and student learning.
  - b. **Adult Theory:** Apply adult learning principles to build collaborative relationships.
  - c. **Assessment:** Analysis and use of data to differentiate and inform instruction.
  - d. **Instruction:** Selection and training of research based instructional practices and interventions that accelerate student learning.
  - e. **Content-Focused Exploration:** Take time to dive into the latest research in your discipline(s).
  - f. **Book Study:** Engage in a book study relevant to coaching and leadership.
2. Network with other coaches in the county to share effective practices and collaborate around challenges unique to a secondary setting.



Our professional learning centers on Diane Sweeney's Student Centered Coaching Model to document our impact on student learning. The model is an evidence-based instructional coaching model that shifts the focus from 'fixing' teachers to collaborating with them to design instruction that targets student outcomes. While our focus is on Diane Sweeney's work, we also draw on other experts from the field.
