



What is AVMR?

The Add+VantageMR® program provides teachers with efficient and effective assessment tools to recognize their students' current understandings of number concepts, and to support data-driven instruction. Forming **collegial teams is encouraged** during the course to provide for ongoing study. Add+VantageMR® teachers analyze and modify instructional tasks to meet the needs of a diverse range of students. This expertise allows teachers to customize any commercial mathematics package specifically for the individual children in their classroom. Add+VantageMR® level of assessment and analysis is particularly useful in forming small group instruction within a math classroom.

Math Recovery®'s Add+VantageMR® Course 1

Course length: 4 full-day sessions 8:30AM – 3:00PM
